first complete translation of the Bible into English.


Jan Hus, Hus also spelled Huss, (born c. 1370—



Strong Tower Radio's Budget

We currently have 15 stations on the air, 6 full-time employees, and our budget is only \$585,000! At the end of our fiscal budget, September 30th, we are short \$33,000!

We always pay ALL our bills first, then payroll. Unfortunately, because of this shortfall, our staff has not received a paycheck in 4 weeks, and some needed equipment will not get replaced.

We need 650 monthly donors giving \$75 a month, and we would have had \$585,000! We currently have about 400 monthly donors. Being Reformation month, we need to reform our thinking!!

Please pray and ask God what He would have you do to help financially support Strong Tower Radio. Time is short, folks; Jesus IS coming back soon! As always, thank you for your love, prayers, AND financial support.

The STR team (and many of you) has been praying to receive ten new stations for which we applied last

November. Decisions are now final, and the FCC has granted eight of the ten signals; praise God! Many are financially giving for these new stations, and fundraising continues for the miraculous Grand Haven station purchase. With \$300,000 raised, \$129,000 is still needed to fully fund the purchase of WMPA, 93.1 FM, Grand Haven; praise God!

Not only does STR need the Holy Spirit's further preparation for a much greater reach, but churches in new areas to be covered by Strong Tower Radio also need the Lord's preparation. It won't be IF, but WHEN new STR station listeners walk into churches and want to embrace the full gospel! By the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit, church members will be prepared to welcome listeners and encourage them in their walk with Jesus.

Your continued prayers and financial gifts keep us broadcasting 24/7/365 on 15 stations with 8 new stations FCC approved for construction. Thank you for praying continually for STR listeners as they respond to the truth-filled messages and for funding their opportunity to hear the everlasting gospel. May the joy of the Lord be your strength!
