

A Father's Day Message for Us All Building Godly Fathers in an Ungodly World

We live in an increasingly godless world where moral lines are blurred. What was once right is now wrong, and what was once wrong is now right. Today a man can claim to be a woman or anything in-between. It's a world upside down. In this so-called "Brave New World," children are filled with anxiety, anger, and confusion.



And in this post-Covid era, we, as Christians, find ourselves getting sucked into polarizing conversations about everything from gender fluidity to critical race theory, which generate a lot of heat but very little light. 
How to Celebrate Father's Day at Your Church
